Walk with Ease



Tennessee Agriculture Enhancement Program (TAEP)

The Tennessee Agricultural Enhancement Program (TAEP) was established in 2005 to provide cost share dollars to agricultural producers for the purpose of making long-term investments in Tennessee farms and communities.

Participation allows producers to maximize farm profits, adapt to changing market situations, improve operation safety, increase farm efficiency, and make a positive economic impact in their communities.

More than \$224 million has been invested in 74,619 producer projects from 2005-2021.

Eligibility for TAEP can be found within each application. There are three types:

1. <u>Application A</u> which includes: Genetics, Livestock Equipment, Hay Storage, Herd Health, Livestock Solutions, Dairy Solutions, Permanent Working Structures, and Row Crop Solutions.

2. <u>Application B</u> which includes: Agritourism, Fruit and Vegetable, Honey Bee, Horticulture, Organic, and Value-Added Products.

3. <u>Application C</u> for Poultry Grower Commercial Producers.

Application period is October 1-7, 2022 and are available for pickup Monday-Friday 8:00am to 4:30pm at the Extension office.


Hey, Get Your "Bulb" Over Here!

Tips for Fall Bulbs Plantings.

- Fall planting usually means September to October plantings.
- Know the light requirement for your bulbs; full sun is usually best.
- Be sure to plant the bulb at the correct depth.
- Plant in groupings for the best effect.
- Plan out your plantings, stacking bulbs plantings will allow for blooms at different times and utilizes your space wisely.


